

Ordering Custom T-Shirts? Use This Checklist!

1	General Planning	What's the purpose of the shirts (event, merch, staff uniforms)? Who will be wearing them (demographic, sizes)? Do you have a specific of orders number or will you be creating an inventory? What's the quantity needed?
2	Design Considerations	Do you have a design or need help creating one? How many colors are in the design? Will the design go on dark or light fabric?
3	Decoration Method Matching	Direct-to-Film - Best for small runs or full-color designs Screen-Printing - Best for large orders and bold colors Simulated Stitch - Want the look of embroidery without the cost? Dye Sublimation Patches - Need fine detail in patch form? Heat Transfer - Versatile and fast for uniforms or workwear Chenille - Going for vintage/varsity vibes? Embroidery - Classic, textured, and professional Puff Embroidery - Want 3-D pop? Laser-Etched Leather - Classy, high-detail branding Debossed Leather - Understated, minimalist elegance
4	Fabric Considerations	Choosing cotton, cotton/poly blends, or specialty fabrics? Is the fabric thick or stretchy? (Important for embroidery) Will it be washed often or worn for short-term use?
